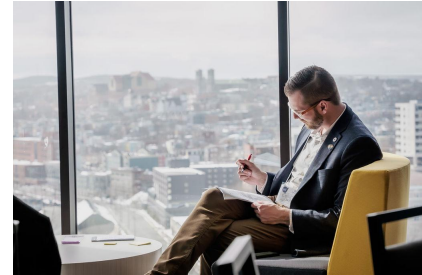

The (Economic) Impact of the Community Sector: A reflection from Colin

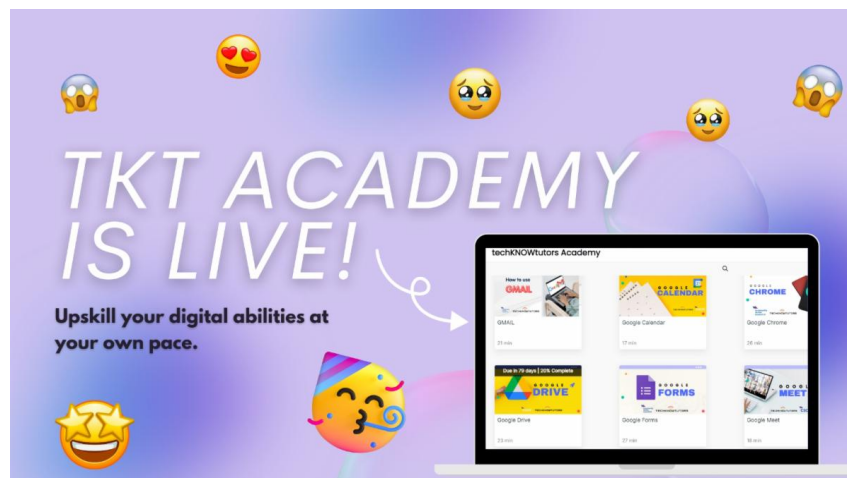
