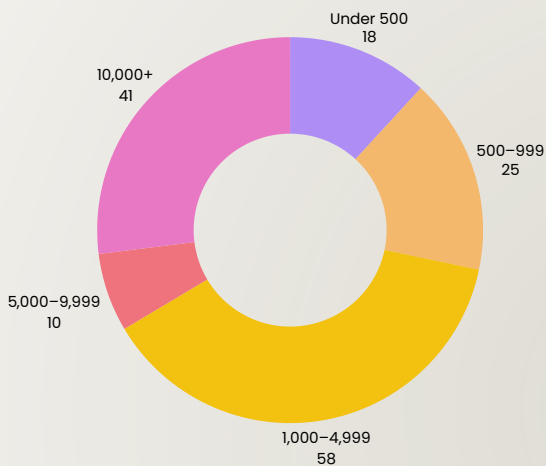


AMPLIFY 2025-26 HIGHLIGHTS

The Community Sector Council of Newfoundland and Labrador, in partnership with the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador, Department of Jobs, Growth, and Rural Development, delivered an employment and career and personal development project for youth facing barriers to employment across the province. These results reflect the impact of the program across the province in 2025.

YOUTH POPULATION AND GEOGRAPHIC DISPERSION



DEEP REACH: 152 Youth from 76 Communities!

AMPLIFY’s reach extended across 76 communities, from the province’s largest centres to some of its most rural and remote regions. Over 66% of youth participants in 2025 came from communities of under 5,000 people!
